This letter is to provide you with information on Arizona's *Move on When Reading*

the four exemptions to retention in AR [redacted] in AR [redacted] school district governing board or the governing body of a charter school [redacted] to promote a student who fails to meet the cut score on the 3rd grade AzMERIT exam for any of the four following reasons: [redacted] www.azed.gov

- (i) A third grade student is an English Language Learner who is Proficient and has received fewer than two years of English instruction;
- (ii) A third grade student with disabilities has an individualized education plan (IEP), and the IEP team, which includes the student's parent, agrees that promotion is appropriate; or [redacted]
- (iii) A third grade student is in the process of a special education referral or evaluation for placement in special education and/or students that have been diagnosed as having a significant reading impairment, including dyslexia; or
- (iv) A third grade student has demonstrated or subsequently demonstrates sufficient reading skills or adequate progress towards sufficient reading skills of the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade reading standards as evidenced through a collection of reading assessments approved by the State Board.
